




## Scoring But Not Soaring


In footballing terms, there is no country more successful than Brazil: four time World Cup winners, twice runners-up, the nation that gave us


Pelé is no-doubt a force to be reckoned with on the pitch.


**But what about the country's success off the pitch?** This graphic explores levels of prosperity in Brazil. Most data are taken from the Legatum Prosperity Index™, where Brazil ranks 46th overall. The Prosperity Index™ incorporates a mixture of traditional economic indicators alongside measurements of wellbeing and life satisfaction. Comparing countries in a range of areas, from health to social capital, it provides a more complete picture of global prosperity than any other tool of its kind.
